# Taking the classroom temperature 

A proposed law would require action to relieve heat conditions when a classroom hits $82^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ and that a classroom be vacated entirely should the temperature rise to $88^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.


Too hot to the point that the room can't be occupied safely.

Classrooms with lower temperatures and air ventilation improve learning ability.

At $82^{\circ}$ steps must be taken to relieve the extreme heat condition in the school facility.

SED mandates a minimum classroom temperature of $65^{\circ}$ in cold months.

Too cold can have negative effects on your health.
