

APRIL 2015 ALL URBAN CONSUMERS

The United States City Average Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for April 2015 was 236.599 representing a change of -0.2 percent over the index for April 2014.

The Northeast Area Consumer Price Index for April 2015 was 251.760— representing a change of -0.3 percent over the index for April 2014.

The New York-Northern New Jersey Area Consumer Price Index for April 2015 was 259.959— representing a change of 0.0 percent over the index for April 2014.

The April CPI will be available June 18, 2015.

Future projections of the CPI by businesses and economic organizations are found on page 3. CPI increases are projected at 0.2 percent for 2015 and 2.2 percent for 2016.

Projecting Increases in the Consumer Price Index (CPI)

A large number of organizations project increases in the Consumer Price Index. NYSUT subscribes to *Blue Chip Economic Indicators*. This monthly publication presents 2015 and 2016 economic projections from approximately 50 sources.

Projected Increases in the Consumer Price Index U.S. City Average All Urban Consumers

<u>Blue Chip Economic Indicators</u>, published by Aspen Publishers, Inc. This forecast uses the projections from approximately 50 different organizations and the mean of these projections is reported here.

Blue Chip also reports that 19 of the 49 forecasters contributing to its 2015 consensus CPI projection were revised upward from the prior month. Sixteen forecasts were unchanged and 14 were revised downward. Twenty-five of the 48 forecasts for 2016 were unchanged, 12 were revised upward and 11 were revised downward.

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
