#### Where should a debate watch party be held?

You can hold a debate watch party almost anywhere there is a television—your home, the local union office, a local pub or restaurant, or the veterans' hall, for example.

#### What happens at a debate watch party?

We want you to have a great time at your party! Building enthusiasm for Hillary Clinton is job one. This is a great opportunity to build a cadre of volunteers to get out the vote. Engaging our members in the primary and general election effort must be a top priority. So use this opportunity to encourage your members to sign up to volunteer for our political mobilization program.

#### Who should come to a debate watch party?

We want you to encourage other AFT members and their families to come to the party. Use fliers, leaflets and email to encourage people to attend. Ask each person you invite to bring another AFT member along. Use your building representatives or stewards to distribute the fliers to members.

#### How do I get information on Hillary Clinton's positions on our issues?

Included in this kit is a two-pager on where Hillary stands on the issues. Additional fliers are available on AFT LeaderNet that highlight Hillary's positions on issues important to our members. Feel free to copy and distribute this information at your party.

Have plenty of food and drink on hand.



Make it a family-friendly event, if possible. Having something for the kids to do will bring out more of our members.



Make sure you get members to sign in when they arrive. Use the attached sign-in sheet.



Have some prizes for both adults and kids.



Facilitate a discussion around the issues important to our members before the debate starts. Then listen to see if those issues are discussed during the debate.
