A proposed law would require action to relieve heat conditions when a classroom hits 82°F and that a classroom be vacated entirely should the temperature rise to 88°F.

**TOO
HOT**

88°

Too hot to the point that the room can't be occupied safely.

82°

At 82° steps must be taken to relieve the extreme heat condition in the school facility.

Classrooms with lower temperatures and air ventilation improve learning ability.

68°

65°

SED mandates a minimum classroom temperature of 65° in cold months.

**TOO
COLD**

60°

Too cold can have negative effects on your health.
