

SEPTEMBER 2018 ALL URBAN CONSUMERS

The United States City Average Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for **September 2018** was **252.439**— representing a change of **2.3** percent over the index for **September 2017**.

The Northeast Area Consumer Price Index for **September 2018** was **266.709**—representing a change of **2.2** percent over the index for **September 2017**.

The New York-Northern New Jersey Area Consumer Price Index for **September 2018** was **275.455**— representing a change of **2.0** percent over the index for **September 2017**.

The October CPI will be available November 14, 2018.

Future projections of the CPI by businesses and economic organizations are found on page 3. CPI increases are projected at **2.5** percent for **2018** and **2.3** percent for **2019**.

A large number of organizations project increases in the Consumer Price Index. NYSUT subscribes to *Blue Chip Economic Indicators*. This monthly publication presents 2018 and 2019 economic projections from approximately 50 sources.

<u>Blue Chip Economic Indicators</u>, published by Aspen Publishers, Inc. This forecast uses the projections from approximately 50 different organizations and the consensus of these projections is reported here.

<u>Blue Chip</u> also reports that 10 of the 50 forecasters contributing to its **2018** consensus CPI projection were revised upward from the prior month. Thirty-six forecasts were unchanged and 4 were revised downward. Twenty-six of the 50 forecasts for **2019** were unchanged, 15 were revised upward and 9 were revised downward.

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
