

DECEMBER 2018 ALL URBAN CONSUMERS

The United States City Average Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for **December 2018** was **251.233** — representing a change of **1.9** percent over the index for **December 2017**.

The Northeast Area Consumer Price Index for **December 2018** was **265.286**—representing a change of **1.7** percent over the index for **December 2017**.

The New York-Northern New Jersey Area Consumer Price Index for **December 2018** was **273.836**— representing a change of **1.6** percent over the index for **December 2017**.

The **January** CPI will be available **February 13, 2019**.

Future projections of the CPI by businesses and economic organizations are found on page 3. CPI increases are projected **1.9** percent for **2019 and 22 percent for 2020.**

The Average Annual Change in the CPI for the 2018 calendar year was 2.4%. This is important because under the tax cap law, allowable increases in the property tax levy are based on either 2 percent or the rate of inflation, whichever is less. Therefore, districts will use a 2.0% inflation factor when they are calculating their tax levy limit for 2019-20. Districts must use a nine-step formula to calculate their tax levy limit and submit this information to the NYS Office of State Comptroller by March 1, 2019.
