

## FEBRUARY 2019 All Urban Consumers

The United States City Average Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for February 2019 was 252.776— representing a change of 1.5 percent over the index for February 2018.

The Northeast Area Consumer Price Index for **February 2019** was **266.706**—representing a change of **1.3** percent over the index for **February 2018**.

The New York-Northern New Jersey Area Consumer Price Index for February 2019 was 275.823— representing a change of 1.3 percent over the index for February 2018.

The March CPI will be available April 10, 2019.

Future projections of the CPI by businesses and economic organizations are found on page 3. CPI increases are projected **1.8** percent for **2019** and **2.2** percent for **2020**.

<u>Blue Chip</u> also reports that 6 of the 48 forecasters contributing to its **2019** consensus CPI projection were revised upward from the prior month. Twenty forecasts were unchanged and 22 were revised downward. Five the 47 forecasts for **2020** were unchanged, 39 were revised upward and 3 were revised downward.

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
