is the 25th United States Secretary of Labor, serving in the Obama administration, and is the first Hispanic woman to serve in the U.S. Cabinet. She is a member of the Democratic Party and served in the United States House of Representatives from 2001 to 2009, representing California's 31st and 32nd congressional districts. Raised in California by immigrant parents from Nicaragua and Mexico, Solis has strong union roots. Her father was a Teamsters shop steward in Mexico, and again organized for the Teamsters upon arriving in the United States. Her mother was a member of the United Rubber Workers and an advocate for proper working conditions.
