Greetings Retirees,

As the filling of income tax forms quickly approaches, I am reminded of that catchy ad that asks, "What's in Your Wallet?" In my wallet, I found an enhanced driver's license, credit cards, a new health insurance card, my NYSUT membership card and some cash. This year COLA (Cost-of-living Adjustment) will boost our Social Security by 2.8% and our NYSTRS retirement pension by 1.2%. But these gains will be erased by present high increases of insurance premiums. We are constantly dealing with uncertainty as to what the future will bring. Will Medicare, Social Security and our pensions be reduced or will they be cut completely. We need to support NYSUT's local, state and national efforts to fight for what we know is right. RC 2 is already preparing to attend NYSUT's RA (Representative Assembly) in Albany on April 30 – May 2. At this convention we will help NYSUT to develop legislative policies and vote on amendments to NYSUT's constitution. And we will review, debate, and vote on proposed resolutions for future considerations. This allows all convention delegates to participate in democratic policy-making process.

It's still cold outside but I am looking forward to Spring filled with flowers, showers and sunshine. I'll try to file my income tax forms on time and hope you'll do the same. And maybe we'll even get a tax refund – wouldn't that be great!

Joanne made countless significant contributions as a NYSUT leader over the years and was honored with the NYSUT Legends Award in 2023. Joanne served as president of the Grand Island Teachers Association for 19 years and oversaw contract negotiations for several subsequent contracts.
