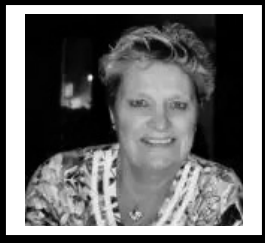


**CONGRATULATIONS TO TRACY BEATTY—
