

Joanne made countless significant contributions as a NYSUT leader over the years and was honored with the NYSUT Legends Award in 2023. She will be remembered for her dedication, leadership, and unwavering Commitment to our Union family.

Joanne served as president of the Grand Island Teachers Association for 19 years and oversaw contract negotiations for several subsequent contracts.
