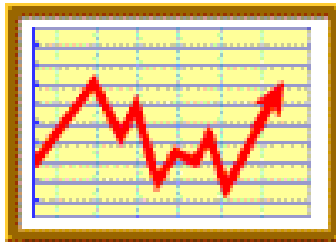


# Consumer Price Index

## MAY 2015 ALL URBAN CONSUMERS

The United States City Average Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for **May 2015** was **237.805** representing a change of **0.0** percent over the index for **May 2014**.

The Northeast Area Consumer Price Index for **May 2015** was **252.770**— representing a change of **-0.3** percent over the index for **May 2014**.

The New York-Northern New Jersey Area Consumer Price Index for **May 2015** was **261.066**— representing a change of **-0.1** percent over the index for **May 2014**.

The June CPI will be available July 17, 2015.

***CPI increases are projected at 0.2 percent for 2015 and 2.2 percent for 2016.***

## ***Projecting Increases in the Consumer Price Index (CPI)***

A large number of organizations project increases in the Consumer Price Index. NYSUT subscribes to *Blue Chip Economic Indicators*. This monthly publication presents 2015 and 2016 economic projections from approximately 50 sources.

### ***Projected Increases in the Consumer Price Index U.S. City Average All Urban Consumers***

***Blue Chip Economic Indicators***, published by Aspen Publishers, Inc. This forecast uses the projections from approximately 50 different organizations and the mean of these projections is reported here.

***Blue Chip*** also reports that 16 of the 52 forecasters contributing to its 2015 consensus CPI projection were revised upward from the prior month. Twenty-four forecasts were unchanged and 12 were revised downward. Twenty-two of the 51 forecasts for 2016 were unchanged, 10 were revised upward and 19 were revised downward.

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
